Casa de Amigos was established in 1964 as an outreach of St. Mark's Methodist Church to serve the needs of Midland's low income and minority residents.



Strategically located on Midland's east side, Casa de Amigos has evolved from a grassroots agency to a major social services community center, serving all ages and ethnic backgrounds.

Over the years, Casa de Amigos has grown from one small building on Dallas Street into a 20,000 square foot community center, housing programs for Senior Services, Health/Dental Services, Education and Social Services.

## *Growing to Serve*

- 1964 – Established by members of St. Mark's Methodist Church
- 1973 – Becomes a United Way member agency
- 1978 – Land donated at present location
- 1979 – First permanent home constructed
- 1984 – First expansion
- 1990 – Facility expanded to current 20,000 sq. ft.
- 2003 – Organized Casa de Amigos Endowment Foundation Board of Directors to ensure the agency's effectiveness far into the future
